We use the few minutes at the start of the service to reflect quietly, and to prepare individually to join in worship. This booklet contains words we will say and pray together, and the words to our songs and hymns.

CRÈCHE

CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE

Sunday School is provided for age 3 upwards to children in P5. The children join us for the first part of the service and then leave for age appropriate classes early in the service. Children need to be signed in on arrival in the foyer and signed out again when collected downstairs by a parent/carer. P6&7 and secondary school age children remain with us in the service throughout.



Trinity Flowers


